A Christian Prays for the Church

Dear Jather in Deaven: in Your mercy, You called me to faith in Your Son, by Your Spirit. You did not leave me in the misery of failure: failing to live up to the righteous standard of true holiness; failing to find an answer for the guilt of my sin.
