### Reflections on the Christmas Tree

Year after year, early in the month of December, a race was on at our house in Michigan.

You see, if we were not quick about it; if we didn't make our plans, take the time for a family outing, pick out a Christmas tree, bring it home and drag it in and set it up in time, my Grandpa (who lived less than a five minute drive up the road) would supply one.

Year after year, a tree would magically appear out on the redwood deck, just outside the sliding glass door where we used to throw our littlest brother out into the snow. Year by year, now, we would shake our heads, irritated by the little present that somehow always seemed to be a joke at our expense.

It seems to me that maybe—just on account of *not being able to pick it out ourselves*—the quirks of the tree were more pronounced to us. But I can recall the Christmas grumbling, the sarcastic laughing, and the holiday head-shaking as we decorated and basked in the glow of some of the most lopsided, misshapen trees any Michigan forest or tree farm ever produced.

Of course, the biggest complaint: we wanted to do it ourselves. My Grandpa has been gone now for several years. I can't tell you how much I wish I could decorate one of the trees he would pick

out for us. I can't help smiling now as I remember the worst one, so bent we had to prop it against the wall so it wouldn't fall on us as we decorated it!

But now it's early December again. The race is on for us—to decorate our lives and our homes. We would like to *do it ourselves*. We'd like to guarantee our own choices. Take charge.

But outside in the cold is the gift God the Father has chosen for us, one we would not have chosen for ourselves and which we would still refuse were it not for His call and His work in our hearts by grace.

The poor, Virgin-born, Manger-laid Christ Child is His gift to you. Wrapped in swaddling clothes like the Scriptural promises that told us He was coming, foreshadowing His burial cloths in His death for us, in place of us. He came to fulfill the promise the angel made to Joseph: He will save His people from their sins. Finding Him out in the cold, for us, the race was on, but, You win. Thank you dear Father in heaven. Thank you, dearest Jesus.

- New Leadership for the congregation is under discussion—both new individuals, and new posts. Thank you to all who have been serving the congregation in leadership! Let's also help train in some new leaders for the work of Evangelism and Hospitality, Stewardship and Properties, and God willing, eventually Christian Education. We will also hope to focus on *events* and *tasks*, not just "jobs."
