The Lenten Road

For forty years, the children of Israel traveled the wildnerness. I have travelled that road... in an air conditioned bus. Even then, we sure were on that bus for a long time. How easy to forget all that we have to be grateful for. How easy to forget the Word that we have been given to trust in. How easy to find reasons for complaint—from the heat to the thirst to the pebbles in our shoes. How very like our life with God.

Israel celebrated the Exodus for centuries at the Passover, singing a portion of the Psalms called *The Great Hallel* (which means, appropriately enough, *praise.*) It says in part:

When Israel went out from Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language, ² Judah became his sanctuary, Israel his dominion. ³ The sea looked and fled; Jordan turned back. ⁴ The mountains skipped like rams, the hills like lambs. ⁵ What ails you, O sea, that you flee? O Jordan, that you turn back? ⁶ O mountains, that you skip like rams? O hills, like lambs? ⁷ (Ps 114:1-7)

God actually did this: He claimed a people for Himself—slaves with nothing to offer. He dwelt with them to be their God, and they were His people. The Psalmist joins the sea with the Jordan River—there's a wall of water behind us and a wall of water in front of us, and our whole life is framed by it. What ails the water, that causes it to

open up and make a way through, which water does not want to do? What troubles the mountains and hills? Tremble, O earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob, 8 who turns the rock into a pool of water, the flint into a spring of water. (Ps 114:7-8)

The Lord is present, in the baptismal flood that surrounds you; in His gifts to quench your thirst and revive you. His sanctuary and His dominion—that's what He calls you, His people. A dwelling place for Him and object of His gracious rule. And that He means you, you know by His Words. Follow me. He says: Deny yourselves, take up your cross. Watch and pray. And, The spirit is willing but the flesh is weak.

We marked His path before. He came and sanctified it, blessing us by His blameless living and innocent dying—by which He takes all our sins away.

Pentient but having hope. Somber but joyful. Learning, yet knowing what is ahead—as we look forward to the Last Supper, as we keep watch at our dear Savior's Cross, and as we await word of His victory over the grave. The earth will tremble as He dies. It will shake again on the third day.

God bless you for a watchful and prayerful, hopeful and joyful Lenten Journey.
