There will have to be food. I can close my eyes and still smell the baking from home, when my mother and grandmother worked together for hours baking cookies by the hundreds. Come Christmas Eve we'll do our best to finish whatever is left of them—after the family's traditional late-night dinner of ham and cheese, cold beans, pickles and olives and potato salad.

Our Elders and Council met on Monday, November 3rd at 6:30 PM at the Church. What follows is unofficial minutes:

Summary: Reports from the Pastor, Treasurer, Head Elder and Head Trustee were delivered. An update on new Church exterior lighting was provided. The Council took action to fund painting of the Sunday School classrooms up to \$500.

The meeting was called to order by Vice President/Interim Chairman Dick Welling at 6:30 PM and opened with prayer by the pastor. In attendance: Dick Welling, Norm Hartigan, Bryan Carlson, John Colville, Jim Bonnell, and Pastor Hamilton.

Item, Pastor's Report: October worship attendance averaged 32. Three adults are continuing under instruction, one with regularity. It was noted that some new families have become involved in Church and Sunday School lately.

Item, Treasurer's Report: YTD our giving has kept pace with our needs, and to date we remain approximately \$9000 to the good.

Item, Elders: Dick attended and represented our congregation and our synod at the Joint Reformation service at Emmanuel, Tempe (WELS).

Item, Trustees: The front door has sustained some damage and will need to be repaired with stain at potentially greater cost than initially hoped. This project is still in the research stage. No formal action has yet been taken.

Item, Trustees: The crash bar on the door that leads from the parish hall to the patio has been repaired and is working properly.

Item, Trustees: A search has begun for someone who can repair the deteriorating interior/exterior door that opens in the flower room.

Item, Trustees: Research on information for new exterior signage continues. Evangelism: No Report.

Item, Trustees/Stewardship: 17 members and friends attended our workday this past month. Thank you!

Item, Christian Education: Å motion was made to fund painting of our Sunday School classrooms up to \$500. m/s/p.

Item: A brief forum was proposed for November 30th to present the 2026 budget, with a special Voter's assembly to ratify just before the Council meets on December 1st. Approved by consensus.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting. m/s/p.

The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer at approximately 7:20pm.
